Leader-In-Training (LIT) Description

Responsibilities:

- Assist with supervision and instruction of lessons for four and five year old campers at camp from 9:00-12:00 each day.
- Aid campers with projects, games and activities
- Assist in planning activities throughout the week
- Help with preparation and clean up of materials
- Contribute to all camp special events and large group activities
- Demonstrate an in-depth understanding of the topic for the week

Dates:

Minimum commitment of one session (one week): July 5-9; July 19-23; August 2-6; or August 16-20.

General Requirements:

- Mature and responsible, good role model for younger children
- Interest in or experience working with children
- Interest in nature and being outdoors
- Willingness to be flexible and help with a variety of activities
- Age requirement 13-15

Benefits:

- Receive training and experience in working with young children and environmental sciences
- Develop relationships with younger children.
- Participate in wildlife or environmental project and/or fieldtrip
- Interact with other staff in a cooperative learning community
- Gain valuable experience for future employment and education

If accepted, the LIT must also complete the packet of emergency and health forms required of all campers, as well as submit a youth employment certificate (obtained from your school) and sign a contract agreeing to the terms of the position. Forms will be provided upon acceptance.

LIT positions are limited to 3 per session, so early application is recommended.
